Climate in the Northern Soya Region

The region's climate is characterized by low daily maximum temperatures, which only rarely exceed 25 °C even in summer, as well as strong winds year-round in coastal areas. Inland, summer temperatures occasionally reach around 30 °C, with great temperature variation throughout the day.

Cautions for Cycling in Northern Soya

1. Pack warm clothing, even in summer

Even in summer, temperatures may drop in the mornings, evenings, or at high-elevation passes. During descents or periods of low physical activity, speed and wind will chill your body.

2. Confirm food and water points

Outside of urban areas, there may be spans of dozens of kilometers without availability of food or water. Make sure to carry sufficient supplies.

3. Be careful of busy national highways

Caution is necessary when riding on national highways, which have high traffic volume, and major roads, which are frequented by large vehicles. Also note that vehicles tend to travel faster on Hokkaido's typically wide, long, and straight roads.

4. Be careful of encounters with wild animals.

Hokkaido is known for its abundant wildlife, including charming Hokkaido squirrels and Ezo sika deer. However, cyclists must be cautious of dangerous animals, such as the fierce brown bear, and the Ezo red fox, which carries echinococcus parasites.
